MINUTES OF THE MEETING – 23 JULY 2022

1. Need for more faculty members at the assistant dean level across three schools to address academic queries stressed upon.
2. Open content production schedule to be looked at and followed up on.
3. Academic writing MOOC preliminary prep is ready. *Approval for academic writing needs to be passed down from Coursera to SkillUp so that Madhura can start recording soon.*
4. JSIA is currently working on culling parts of the MA IRSS degree program to develop them as independent MOOCs for stackability.
5. Handbook information is already up on the onboarding course. Information to be picked up from the onboarding course is to be included in the handbook.
6. JSJP also working on an internal operational manual.
7. JSJP proposing opening individual courses as MOOCs on Coursera after 2 years (one cycle)
8. Create digital assets - get ambassadors and experts who are part of the JGU faculty to talk about an issue of global significance.
9. Appoint 'tutors' who will shadow faculty - can be done on a need-based basis for now. JSIA to appoint tutors full-time.
10. JGU is in talks with Pearsons to bring in proctored examinations for the final exam component. Ashish and Indranath to lead this effort.
11. Faculty will be fatigued if they must teach in summer and winter breaks and also in academic terms. VC - Work with APCI/make tweaks in teaching allocation.
12. Reimagine social media outreach and campaigns. Create a Centre for online education as an institutional home for all such programs.
13. Conversation about Coursera being more aggressive with their marketing efforts.
