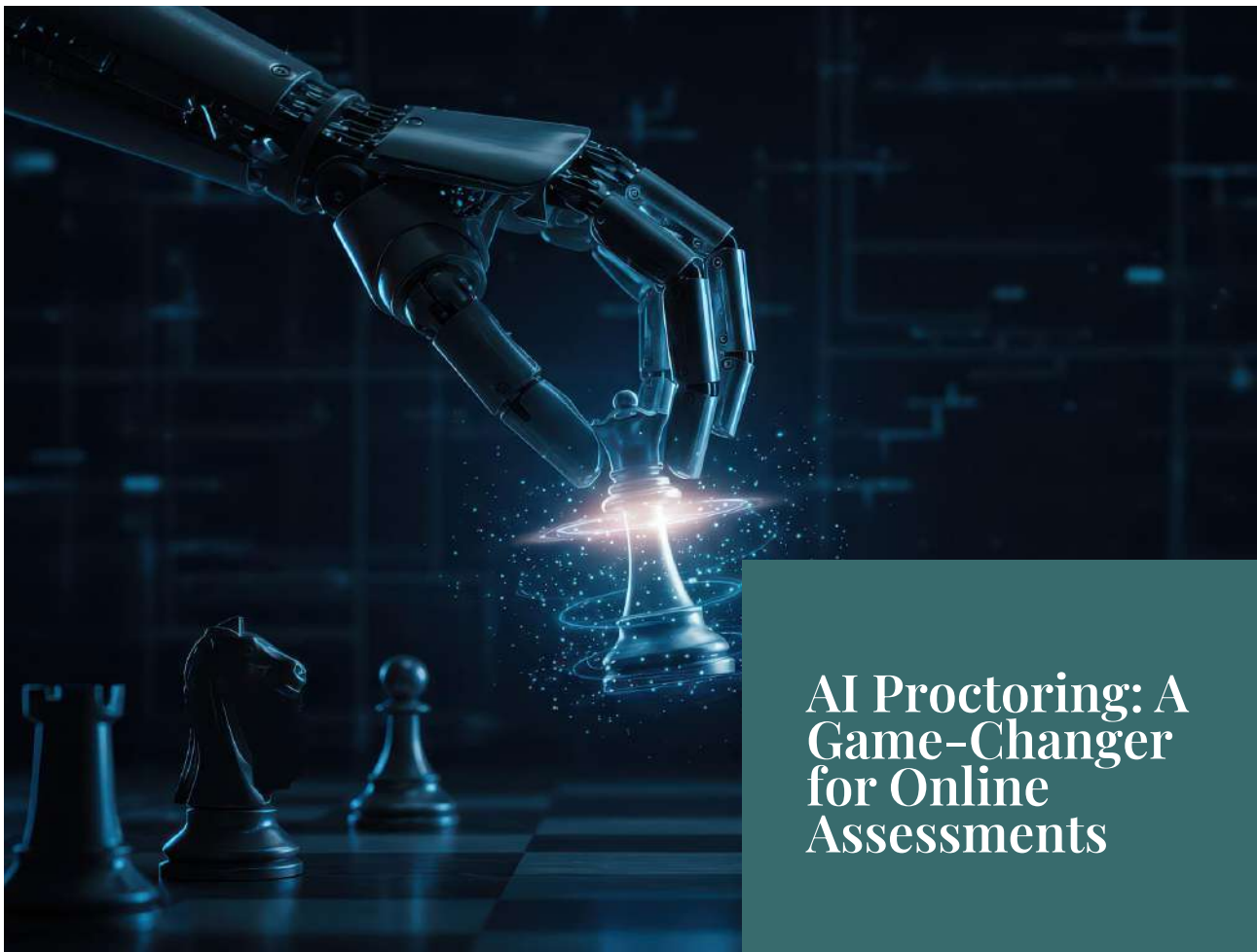

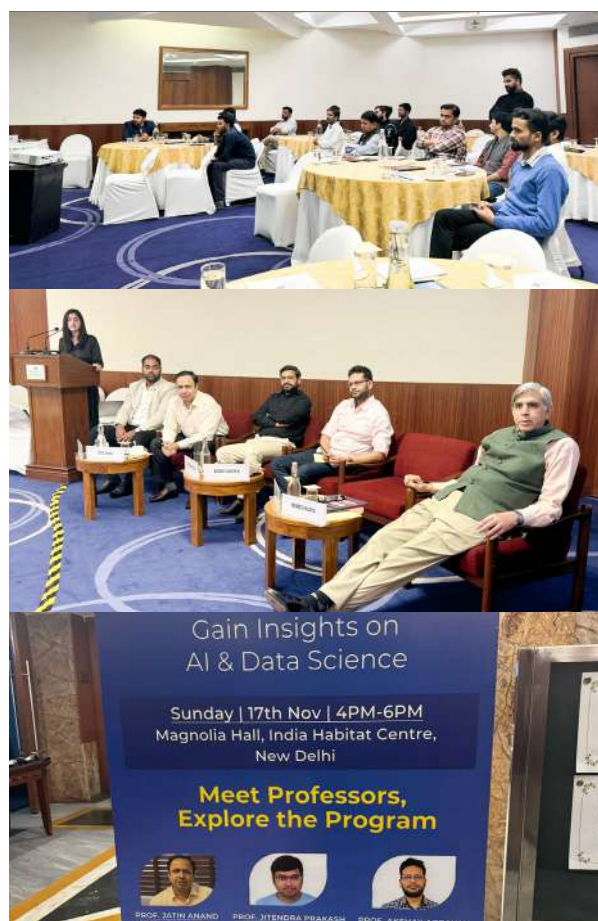

questions on admissions, careers, and flexible study options.

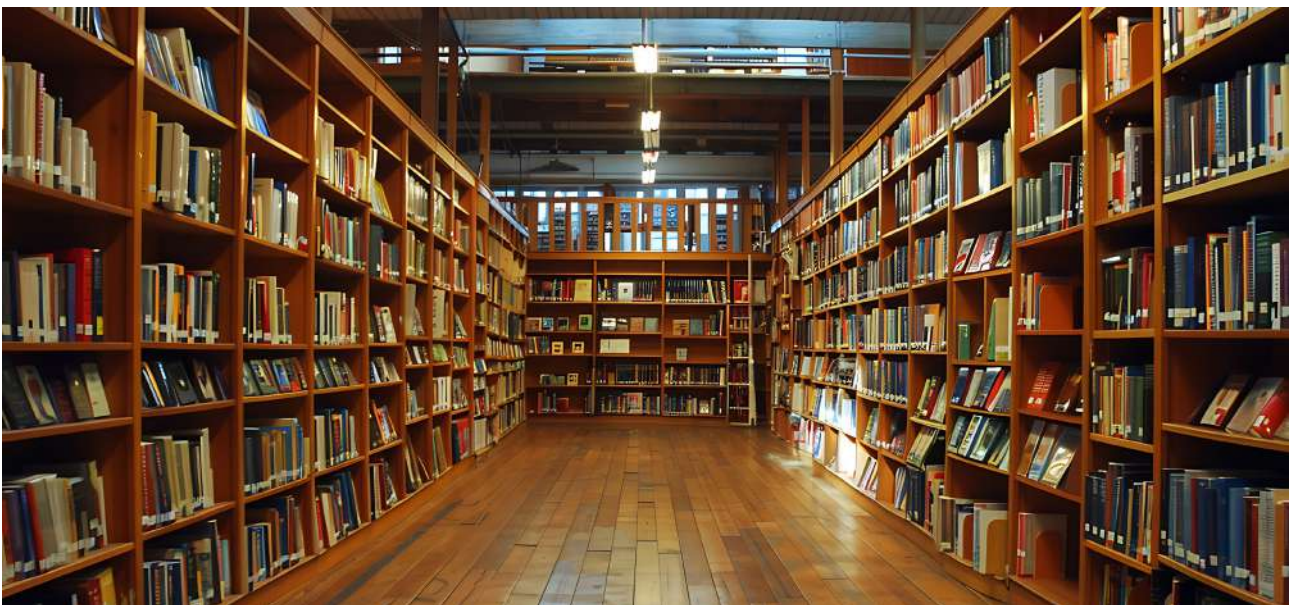

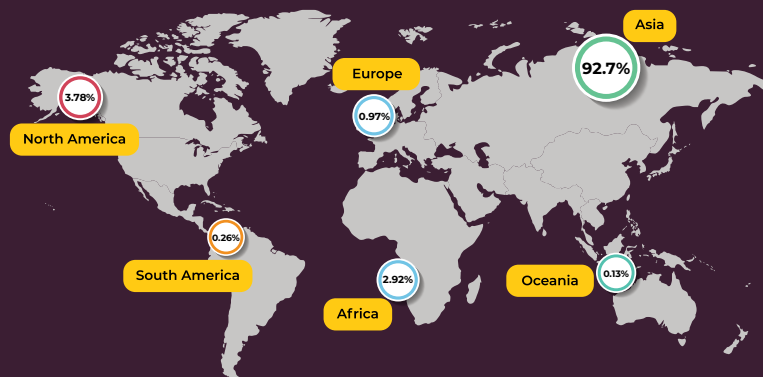
